



Assembly Video Delivery Guide

This video was produced to recreate a typical Scouts school assembly, it's 7 mins 6 seconds long and straight forward for any adult to deliver. There are 2 interactive sections where we ask the young people to chat to one another or feedback to the whole class.

- 1 mins 21 seconds – at this point there will be a compilation of video clips and photos showing the different types of activities we do in Scouts, the video will ask them to watch the activities closely so they can feedback to the class. At 1 min 51 seconds there will be a reminder of the challenge and then about 1 minute for your students to feedback. During this time some clues will appear on the video, could you please read these out and ask your students to guess which activity you're describing, the answer will then appear on the video. If you want to spend more time discussing the different activities please just pause the video.
- 3 mins 27 seconds – the video will ask young people who are already part of Scouts to tell the closest person to them what they enjoy doing at Beavers or Cubs. If they're not part of Scouts yet, they can discuss their favourite things to do outside school. The adults can encourage them by sharing theirs. There will be a timer counting down 30seconds for them to do this.



Optional

While talking about the badges (5 mins 18 seconds), the adult leading can hold up some real badges and maybe pass them to the young people if these have been sent to the school along with any other necessary resources.
