

Q+A: SCOUTS PARTNERSHIP UPDATE

Why do Scouts need to come into the store for our session, that's not how it used to work?

We have made the decision to change how we provide support for Scout and Explorer Groups to support young people in having the best experience possible with their model maker activity by having their session hosted by an expert who is trained to run the session. We will also be empowering Scout Leaders to take the resources back to their meeting place and continue the session there should they wish to.

This decision has also allowed us to reallocate some of our resources to provide additional support for young people in Education and their club leaders globally, making Warhammer more accessible for more people around the world.

Can a Store Manager or Staff member come to a meeting place and run the session?

Unfortunately not. Due to the volume of requests that we receive, our store teams do not have the capability to provide this service.

What do Scouts do if the group is too far / or too big to come to the local store?

Scouts are welcome to send a delegation of Scouts/Leaders to the store. During the session they will take part in the session, collect resources to use with the rest of the group in a future session at their meeting place and have the opportunity to ask questions and hear tips from our teams on running the sessions for themselves. If they are unable to attend a session then unfortunately we will not be able to support their group at this time.

Who can take part in the sessions?

Scouts, Explorers and Scout Leaders. We cannot provide sessions or materials for Cubs, Beavers or Squirrels due to the age recommendations of our products and materials.

What can Scouts and Leaders expect from a session in one of your stores?

A fun and focussed model maker activity experience that provides Scouts and Explorers with the knowledge and skills required for the Model Maker Activity badge. The sessions have been designed based on feedback from Scouts, Leaders and Store Managers.

If they have any questions about a possible session, they are encouraged to talk to their local store manager.

How much does it cost?

There is no charge for the resources or the session.

What if my group would like to do more sessions with Warhammer?
