What does the team do?

The England Programme Team exists to provide strategic support to English counties on ensuring that every young person in Scouting can access an exciting, quality programme. Primarily working with county programme teams, the team takes a bottom up approach, to proactively listening to and responding to the challenges they face. This includes the delivery of regular programme road shows around England. Furthermore, the England programme team plays an active role in the UK programme team, feeding in the needs of English counties to programme developments.

What we're looking for

We are looking for at least one more member of the team, to support it's work, including taking a leading role in the organisation and delivery of workshops to county programme team leaders.

We consider this position as an entry position into national leadership, and we do not expect any specific experience. Instead, we look for candidates with:

- A commitment to young people and belief in the importance of youth work in England
- A willingness and interest to work at a strategic level, a step removed from Scouting's beneficiaries.
- An interest in supporting the delivery of training and workshops.
- A desire to grow in the role and be proactive in exploring new opportunities for the team's work.

It would be a bonus if:

- You have experience on the coordination of adventurous activities at a regional or national scale, including in relation to the management of qualifications for these activities.
- You have lived experience that can bring a diverse perspective to the team, particularly that of ethnic and religious minorities, those from socio-economically disadvantaged backgrounds, and young people.

Time commitments:

- Approximately 1 evening meeting per week, plus 1 evening of self led work per week
- Approximately 8 weekend events per year

How you'll be supported

- The England Programme Team Leader will be your line manager, and they will support you both in your tasks and your personal development.
- All expenses incurred during volunteering will be reimbursed, including travel, meals, and accommodation where necessary.
- You'll be a part of the wider England leadership team, who will also support you informally.
